Bhutan Photography Tour 9 days/8 nights Paro, Thimphu, Wangdue, Punakha, Trongsa & Bumthang

Our immersive nine-day Bhutan Photography tour serves as your gateway to the heart of Bhutan's Himalayan culture.

Day 1: Arrival in Paro

Upon landing at Paro International Airport, our local tour guide will extend a warm welcome and accompany you to your hotel. Freshen up, and embark on an orientation tour of Paro. Visit the captivating Rinpung Dzong, the Ta-dzong (National Museum), and indulge in a short excursion to the newly consyructed Drukgyel Dzong and the 7th century Kyichu Lhakhang. These sites, steeped in Buddhist heritage, provide perfect subjects for your lens. Following this, we will drive you to Thimphu, the Bhutanese capital, offering picturesque photo opportunities during the one-hour journey. En route, feel free to capture rural life, quaint villages, and the stunning landscape. In Thimphu, after hotel check-in, take a city stroll. In the evening, explore night photography at the National Memorial Chorten and Kuenselphodrang.

Day 2: Thimphu Unveiled

Early morning, capture the Thimphu Valley's panoramic beauty from Kuenselphodrang. With the world's tallest Bronze Buddha statue as a centerpiece, this locale offers diverse photographic opportunities. Post-breakfast, visit the painting school, Folk Heritage Museum, and the National Library. After lunch, explore the 13th century Changangkha Lhakhag (temple), Motithang Takin Preserve, and Dechenphodrang Monastery. In the evening, visit Tashichhodzong to capture its architectural splendor and monks' activities.

Day 3: Thimphu to Trongsa

Embark on a day-long adventure filled with captivating scenes. Pause at Dochula Pass for breakfast and coffee, surrounded by Himalayan mountain panoramas and traditional 108 stupas. Proceed through dense forests, verdant valleys, and rustic settlements, eventually reaching Wangdue Valley.

Capture the 17th century Wangdue Dzong, which was recently consecrated after a fire burned down the fortress. Continue to Pelela Pass, yet another photography

hotspot, and descend through picturesque valleys and rural life. During winter, you will encounter yaks and herders. Stop at Chendebji Chorten for tea and coffee and photography, followed by a picturesque viewpoint offering a majestic glimpse of Trongsa Dzong. Overnight halt in Trongsa.

Day 4: Trongsa to Bumthang

After breakfast, visit the magnificent Trongsa Dzong, perched on a ridge overlooking Mangdichhu. Explore the main shrine, home to the Buddha of three eras, and capture the courtyard's essence. Visit Ta Dzong, housing the museum. After lunch, journey to Bumthang, with scenic stops for photographic breaks.

Day 5: Bumthang Unveiled

Capture the mesmerizing Chamkhar Valley, cloaked in morning mist and golden sunrays. After breakfast, visit Jakar Dzong, poised atop a hill with a stunning valley backdrop. Visit Jambay Lhakhang and Kurje Lhakhang, each offering thrilling photography prospects. Hike to the Tamshing Monastery and Koenchogsum Temple across Chamkhar River. Lunch in Chamkhar town, followed by evening photography.

Day 6: Bumthang to Punakha

Return to western Bhutan. Arrive in Punakha, exploring night photography near Punakha Dzong.

Day 7: Punakha to Paro

Depart for Kabesa valley to explore morning photography at Khamsum Yuellay Namgyal Chhorten. Hike to the stupa, enjoying the scenic landscape and architecture. Breakfast with a view. Explore Kuenrey inside Punakha Dzong. Visit Chimi Lhakhang (Temple of fertility) and return to Paro, with sunset photography at Dochula Pass.

Day 8: Tiger's Nest Hike

Embark on an epic hike to Taktshang (Tiger's Nest), an iconic Bhutanese heritage site perched on a cliff. Capture this spiritual marvel and indulge in a traditional stone bath. Savor dinner at a local farmhouse.

Day 9: Depart from Paro

After breakfast, your tour guide will accompany you to the airport for your homeward journey, carrying cherished photographic memories of Bhutan.
